

U18 Boys Tournament

Saturday, August 20th and Sunday, August 21st

Format

All teams will play round robin games on Saturday. The seven teams will be divided into two Pools - three teams in Pool A and four teams in Pool B. Teams in Pool A will each play two 90-minute games and teams in Pool B will each play three 60-minute games. Team positions will be identified before the start of the tournament.

As there are an odd number of teams, one team will not play in the first round, which starts at 9:00 am on Saturday. This team (4th place in the season standings), will not play its first game until 11:30 am. The Coach will be notified before Saturday.

The top two teams from each Pool will play in the semi-final games starting at 10:30 am on Sunday and the Final game of the tournament will be played at 1:30 pm.

Rules and Scoring

League rules concerning scoring and discipline are attached (note that the document says "2007"; however, it is current). Please remember that the tournament games are considered an extension of the regular season so any discipline issues will carry on through the weekend (for example, sitting out a weekend game as a result of a card during the last week of regular play).

Just as during the regular season, teams must be able to field at least seven players or forfeit the game in question.

Administration

Schedules, results, notices, discipline, etc. will be displayed at the Scorekeeper's tent which is located close by the fields.

Barbour Field is located on Eighth Line in Hillsburgh, off Side Road 22. Directions are on the League website www.escarpmentsoccer.com .

Minor first-aid supplies (band-aides, cold compresses, etc.) will be available at the tent. Directions to the nearest hospital in Orangeville (approximately 15 minutes by car) will be posted.

There are washrooms on site and the snack bar will be open on both days. There is a grocery store in both Hillsburgh and Erin and a Tim Horton's, Subway, Pizza, etc in Erin.

Bottled water will be provided to all teams.

Awards

Medals/Trophies will be presented to the League winners, the Tournament winners and the losing finalists on Sunday.

Officials

The Tournament referees are from neutral clubs - Brampton, Rockwood and Milton. Assistants are from Brampton as well as HEADS.

Notes

- There will be three teams in Pool A and four teams in Pool B.
- Teams will be identified as soon as possible. It is League policy that teams from the same town (i.e. Bolton) do not play in the same Pool, so adjustments may be necessary.
- Six of the seven teams will play at 9:00 am on Saturday. The 4th place team does not play its first game until 11:30 am and will be notified as far in advance as possible.
- All games are at Barbour Field in Hillsburgh.
- Each team in Pool A will play two 90-minute games on Saturday.
- Each team in Pool B will play three 60-minute games on Saturday.
- The Semi-final and Final games are 90 minutes long.
